

Authorization for mixed marriage

The documents requested:

The case of a Moroccan man wishing to marry a foreigner :

For the Moroccan fiancée:

- Certificate of celibacy of fiancée or a copy of the act of divorce or the final judgment of the divorce in case of a former marriage;
- Birth certificate;
- Copy of the criminal record or police clearance in case of birth in Morocco or of the national criminal record (delivered by the Ministry of Justice) in case of birth abroad;
- Medical certificate;
- Copy of the national identity card;
- Four recent photographs.

For the foreign fiancée:

- Certificate of legal capacity for marriage, delivered by the embassy or the consulate of the country of fiancée, certified by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs;
- Copy of the act of the divorce or the final judgment of the divorce in case of former marriage;
- Copy of the birth certificate in conformity with the family book;
- Certificate of residence delivered by the country of origin or the appropriate authorities of the host country if the interested party is resident in Morocco or in any other country other than her country of origin, by taking into account period of validity;
- Certificate of nationality issued by the authorities of her country or the consular services in Morocco or in the host country;
- Copy of the criminal record or police clearance, if the fiancée was born in Morocco or from the national criminal record (Ministry of Justice) if born abroad;
- Certified declaration of confession in the name of the foreign fiancée or a certified copy of the act of conversion to Islam or any other document proving her Islamic confession;
- Medical certificate;
- Copy of the first page of the passport and the page attesting the date of entry in Morocco;
- Four recent photographs.

The case of a Moroccan woman wishing to marry a foreigner :

For the foreign fiancée:

- Certificate of legal capacity for marriage, delivered by the embassy or the consulate of the country of fiancée, certified by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs;
- Copy of the act of the divorce or the final judgment of the divorce in case of former marriage;
- Certificate justifying his profession as well as his income;
- Certificate of residence delivered by the country of origin or the appropriate authorities of the host country if the interested party is resident in Morocco or in any other country other than his country of origin by taking into account the period of validity;
- Certified copy of the act of conversion to Islam or any other document proving his Islamic confession ;
- Birth certificate in conformity with the family book;
- Certificate of nationality delivered by the authorities of his country or the consular authorities accredited in Morocco;
- Copy of the criminal record in case of birth in Morocco or of the national criminal record (Ministry of Justice) in case of birth abroad;
- Medical certificate;
- Copy of the first page of the passport and the page attesting the date of entry in Morocco;
- Four recent photographs.

For the Moroccan fiancée :

- Certificate of celibacy of the fiancée or a copy of the act of divorce or the final judgment of the divorce, in case of a former marriage;
- Certified approval of tutor for the minor fiancée;
- Birth certificate;
- Certified copy of national identity card;
- Copy of the criminal record or police clearance in case of birth in Morocco or of the national criminal record (Ministry for Justice) in the case of birth abroad;
- Four recent photographs.
